TOWN APPLAUDS TIM HORTONS FOR ADOPTING 14 NEW CLEAN-UP SITES

"Adopt-a-Road is one of the many environmental initiatives the Town runs throughout the year," said Dan Cozzi, Director of Roads and Works Operations. "Litter is a challenge for the Town and community partners, such as Tim Hortons, who commit to this program make a big difference in keeping Oakville clean."
